Key New Testament Verses

Promises, Truths and Commands to Live By

I love the word of God. The bible not only contains God's words but it is God's word. To think less of it is to contradict God's own witness concerning his word.

I decided some years ago to go through my bible book by book and chapter by chapter writing down the key verses that I had marked down over the last 60 years.

In previous studies we have looked for all the key verses in the Old Testament. Then we went through all the Psalms to find key verses that were significantly marked in my bible.

Finally, we complete this study by searching my bible for significant verses that I had previously marked in my study bible. It has been a wonderful disciplined study.

Did I find and mark all the significant verses in the bible? By no means. There are many more verses that should be marked for every word of God is pure and profitable for each of us.

Some of the significant passages are lengthy and I have not included them here, rather I have clipped significant portions to list here. In other studies I have looked for and chosen whole chapters and lengthy paragraphs that I have over the years wanted to commit to memory. That too is a wonderful discipline and a rich source of blessing.

The word of God thrills me. It is like hunting for gold or diamonds hidden among the pages of Scripture. My hope is that these studies will inspire and motivate you to carefully walk through your bible marking those passages that God has pointed out to you over the years of your walk with God.

2 Timothy 3:16-17

All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

Matthew

Matthew 4:19 Follow me, I will make you fishers of men

Come, follow me and I will send you out to fish for people.

Matthew 4:4 Not by bread alone

Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.

Matthew 5:14 You are the light of the world.

You are the light of the world. A city on a hill cannot be hidden.

Matthew 6:24 No one can serve two masters.

No one can serve two masters. Either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and Money.

Matthew 6:34 Do not worry

Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.

Matthew 7:1 Do not judge others

Do not judge, or you too will be judged. For in the same way you judge others, you will be judged, and with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.

Matthew 7:24 Build your house on the rock

Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock.

Matthew 10:29-31

Are not two sparrows sold for a penny ? Yet not one of them will fall to the ground apart from the will of your Father. And even the very hairs of your head are all numbered. So don't be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows.

Matthew 11:28-30

Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls, for my yoke is easy and my burden is light.

Matthew 15:19-20

Matthew 18:15

Matthew 24:35 My word will never pass away

Heaven and earth will pass away but my words will never pass away.

Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.

Matthew 28:6 He is not here, he is risen!

Mark 12:30 The first commandment

You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength: this is the first commandment.

Mark 13:31 My word will never pass away

Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away.

Mark 2:17 The sick need a physician

They that are whole have no need of the physician, but they that are sick: I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.

Mark 6:5-6 He marveled at their unbelief

And he could there do no mighty work, except to lay his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed them. And he marveled because of their unbelief.

Mark 8:34 Take up your cross

Whoever will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me.

Luke

Luke 2:52 Jesus grew

And Jesus grew in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men.

Luke 4:18-19 The Lord anointed me to preach

The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to release the oppressed, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor.

Luke 5:16 Jesus prayed

But Jesus often withdrew to lonely places and prayed.

Luke 5:31-32 The sick need a physician

Jesus answered them, "It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick. I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance."

Luke 6:18 He healed all

All had come to hear him and to be healed of their diseases. Those troubled by evil spirits were cured, and the people all tried to touch him, because power was coming from him and healing them all.

Luke 6:38 Give, Give, Give

Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.

Luke 8:14-15 Some seed fell on good ground

The seed that fell among thorns stands for those who hear, but as they go on their way they are choked by life's worries, riches and pleasures, and they do not mature. But the seed on good soil stands for those with a noble and good heart, who hear the word, retain it, and by persevering produce a crop.

Luke 9:26 If you are ashamed of me

If anyone is ashamed of me and my words, the Son of Man will be ashamed of him when he comes in his glory and in the glory of the Father and of the holy angels.

Luke 10:16 He who listens to me

He who listens to you listens to me; he who rejects you rejects me; but he who rejects me rejects him who sent me.

Luke 10:19-20 I give you authority

I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you. However, do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven.

Luke 11:9-13 Know, Seek, Find

So I say to you: Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; he who seeks finds; and to him who knocks, the door will be opened. Which of you fathers, if your son asks for a fish, will give him a snake instead? Or if he asks for an egg, will give him a scorpion? If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!

Luke 12:29 Don't worry

And do not set your heart on what you will eat or drink; do not worry about it. For the pagan world runs after all such things, and your Father knows that you need them. But seek his kingdom, and these things will be given to you as well.

Luke 12:32 Don't be afraid

Do not be afraid, little flock, for your Father has been pleased to give you the kingdom.

Luke 13:16 Why not heal on the Sabbath?

Then should not this woman, a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan has kept bound for eighteen long years, be set free on the Sabbath day from what bound her?

Luke 13:34 A hen gathers her chicks

O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, you who kill the prophets and stone those sent to you, how often I have longed to gather your children together, as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, but you were not willing!

Luke 14:11 Humility

For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted.

Luke 14:27 Carry your cross

And anyone who does not carry his cross and follow me cannot be my disciple.

Luke 14:34 Salt is good

Salt is good, but if it loses its saltiness, how can it be made salty again?

Luke 15:7 Rejoicing in heaven

I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent.

Luke 15:24 My son was dead and is alive again

For this son of mine was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.

Luke 17:6 Faith as a mustardseed

He replied, "If you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it will obey you.

Luke 17:26 As in the days of Noah

Just as it was in the days of Noah, so also will it be in the days of the Son of Man.

Luke 19:10 He came to seek and save the lost

For the Son of Man came to seek and to save what was lost.

Luke 21:32 The end is near

Even so, when you see these things happening, you know that the kingdom of God is near. I tell you the truth, this generation will certainly not pass away until all these things have happened. Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.

John

John 1:1-3 In the beginning was the word

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning. Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made.

John 1:12 As many as received him

Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God.

John 1:14 The Word became flesh

The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

John 1:29 Behold the Lamb of God

The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!"

John 3:3 You must be born again

In reply Jesus declared, "I tell you the truth, no one can see the kingdom of God unless he is born again."

John 3:16 For God so loved the world

For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

John 3:17 Not to condemn the world

For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him.

John 3:18 Condemned already

Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son.

John 3:19 Men love darkness

This is the verdict: Light has come into the world, but men loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil.

John 3:36 The wrath of God remains on him

Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on him.

John 4:13-14 Living water

Jesus answered, "Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life."

John 4:24 Worship in spirit and truth

God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in spirit and in truth.

John 4:35 The harvest is ripe

Do you not say, 'Four months more and then the harvest'? I tell you, open your eyes and look at the fields! They are ripe for harvest.

John 6:35 Bread of life

Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry, and he who believes in me will never be thirsty."

John 6:37 All the Father gives me will come

All that the Father gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will never drive away.

John 6:44 Unless the Father draws him

No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him, and I will raise him up at the last day.

John 7:37 Come to me and drink

On the last and greatest day of the Feast, Jesus stood and said in a loud voice, "If anyone is thirsty, let him come to me and drink."

John 8:12 The light of life

When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

John 8:32 Truth will set you free

Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.

John 8:36 Free Indeed

Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.

John 8:58 Jesus, the I AM

I tell you the truth," Jesus answered, "before Abraham was born, I am!"

John 10:9-10

I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved. He will come in and go out, and find pasture. The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.

John 10:11 Jesus the Good Shepherd

I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.

John 10:27-29 My sheep hear my voice

My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one can snatch them out of my hand. My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all ; no one can snatch them out of my Father's hand.

John 10:30 Father and Son are one

I and the Father are one.

John 11:25-26 I am the resurrection and life

I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies; and whoever lives and believes in me will never die. Do you believe this?

John 11:35 Jesus wept.

Jesus wept.

John 12:32 I will draw all men to me

But I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all men to myself.

John 14:1 I go to prepare a place for you

Do not let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God; trust also in me. In my Father's house are many rooms; if it were not so, I would have told you. I am going there to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am. You know the way to the place where I am going."

John 14:6 I am the way

I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

John 14:12 Greater works than these

I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in me will do what I have been doing. He will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father.

John 14:13-14 Ask in my name

And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Son may bring glory to the Father. You may ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it.

John 14:26 The Holy Spirit will teach you all things

But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.

John 15:5 I am the Vine

I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.

John 15:7-8

If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be given you. This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples.

John 15:16

You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit--fruit that will last. Then the Father will give you whatever you ask in my name.

John 16:23-24 Ask and receive that your joy may be full

In that day you will no longer ask me anything. I tell you the truth, my Father will give you whatever you ask in my name. Until now you have not asked for anything in my name. Ask and you will receive, and your joy will be complete.

John 16:33 In the world you will have trouble

I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.

John 17:17 Sanctified by the word

Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth.

John 20:31 But these are written that you may believe

But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.

John 21:25 Jesus did much more

Jesus did many other things as well. If every one of them were written down, I suppose that even the whole world would not have room for the books that would be written.

Acts

Acts 1:8 You will receive power

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

Acts 2:38-39 The promise is to you and all afar off

Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. The promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off--for all whom the Lord our God will call."

Acts 2:41-42 They continued in the apostles doctrine, prayers

Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand were added to their number that day. They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.

Acts 3:19-20 Repent and turn to God

Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord, and that he may send the Christ, who has been appointed for you--even Jesus.

Acts 4:12 Salvation is found in no other name

Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved.

Acts 5:42 Day by day they continued to teach and proclaim

Day after day, in the temple courts and from house to house, they never stopped teaching and proclaiming the good news that Jesus is the Christ.

Acts 5:29 We must obey God rather than human beings.

Peter and the other apostles replied: "We must obey God rather than men!"

Acts 10:15 Do not call what God cleansed common or unclean

The voice spoke to him a second time, "Do not call anything impure that God has made clean."

Acts 16:30-31 Believe in the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved.

He then brought them out and asked, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" They replied, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved--you and your household."

Acts 20:32 I commend you to God and the word of his grace

Now I commend you to God and to the word of his grace, which can build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified.

Romans

Romans 1:18- 19 The wrath of God is revealed from heaven

The wrath of God is being revealed from heaven against all the godlessness and wickedness of men who suppress the truth by their wickedness, since what may be known about God is plain to them, because God has made it plain to them.

Romans 3:23 All have sinned

For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

Romans 5:8 God demonstrated his love for us

But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were yet still sinners, Christ died for us.

Romans 6:23 The wages of sin is death

For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 8:26 The Spirit helps our infirmities

In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness.

Romans 8:28 We know that all things work together

And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.

Romans 10:9-10 If we confess with our mouth Jesus Christ

That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved.

Romans 10:17 Faith comes by hearing

Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word of Christ.

Romans 10:12 He richly blesses those who call on him

The same Lord is Lord of all and richly blesses all who call on him.

Romans 10:13 Whoever calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.

For, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

Romans 12:1-2 Present your bodies a living sacrifice

Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God--this is your spiritual act of worship. Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is--his good, pleasing and perfect will.

Romans 12:9-10 Be joyful, patient, faithful

Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer. Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good.

Romans 12:11 Be fervent

Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord.

Romans 12:13 Practice hospitality

Share with God's people who are in need. Practice hospitality.

Romans 12:14 Bless those who curse you

Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse.

Romans 12:15 Weep with those who weep

Rejoice with those who rejoice; mourn with those who mourn.

1 Corinthians

1 Corinthians 1:27-29 God has chosen the foolish things

But God chose the foolish things of the world to shame the wise; God chose the weak things of the world to shame the strong. He chose the lowly things of this world and the despised things--and the things that are not--to nullify the things that are.

1 Corinthians 2:4-5 My message was not in word but in power

My message and my preaching were not with wise and persuasive words, but with a demonstration of the Spirit's power, so that your faith might not rest on men's wisdom, but on God's power.

1 Corinthians 2:910 Eye has not seen nor ear heard

However, as it is written: "No eye has seen, no ear has heard, no mind has conceived what God has prepared for those who love him" -- but God has revealed it to us by his Spirit.

1 Corinthians 3:11-15 Wood, hay and stubble

For no one can lay any foundation other than the one already laid, which is Jesus Christ. If any man builds on this foundation using gold, silver, costly stones, wood, hay or straw, his work will be shown for what it is, because the Day will bring it to light. It will be revealed with fire, and the fire will test the quality of each man's work. If what he has built survives, he will receive his reward. If it is burned up, he will suffer loss; he himself will be saved, but only as one escaping through the flames.

1 Corinthians 6:12 Everything is permissible but I won't be mastered

Everything is permissible for me"--but not everything is beneficial. Everything is permissible for me--but I will not be mastered by anything.

1 Corinthians 6:19-20 You body is the temple of the Holy Spirit

Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your body.

1 Corinthians 8:9 Be careful how you use your freedom

Be careful, however, that the exercise of your freedom does not become a stumbling block to the weak.

1 Corinthians 10:13 All temptations are common to man

No temptation has seized you except what is common to man. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can stand up under it.

1 Corinthians 10:23 Everything is permissible but not beneficial

Everything is permissible--but not everything is beneficial. Everything is permissible--but not everything is constructive.

1 Corinthians 10:31 Whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God.

So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God.

1 Corinthians 13:1 If I have not love it profits me nothing

If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal.

1 Corinthians 13:8 Love never fails

Love never fails.

1 Corinthians 13:11 I put away childish things

When I was a child, I talked like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child. When I became a man, I put childish ways behind me.

1 Corinthians 13:12 We know in part

Now we see but a poor reflection as in a mirror; then we shall see face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I am fully known.

1 Corinthians 13:13 Greatest of these is love

Now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love.

1 Corinthians 15:17-19 If Christ is not raised we are most miserable

For if the dead are not raised, then Christ has not been raised either. And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins. Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ are lost. If only for this life we have hope in Christ, we are to be pitied more than all men.

1 Corinthians 15:33 Bad company corrupts good character.

Do not be misled: "Bad company corrupts good character."

1 Corinthians 15:51-52 we shall be changed

I show you a mystery, we shall be changed declare to you, brothers, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God, nor does the perishable inherit the imperishable. Listen, I tell you a mystery: We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed-- in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed.

1 Corinthians 15:58 You labor is not in vain

Therefore, my dear brothers, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain.

2 Corinthians

2 Corinthians 1:3-4 He comforts us

Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our troubles, so that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves have received from God.

2 Corinthians 1:20 His promises are yea and amen

For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. And so through him the "Amen" is spoken by us to the glory of God.

2 Corinthians 3:17 There is freedom

Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom.

2 Corinthians 4:3-4 Satan has blinded the minds of unbelievers

And even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing. The god of this age has blinded the minds of unbelievers, so that they cannot see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.

2 Corinthians 4:7-9 Treasure in jars of clay

But we have this treasure in jars of clay to show that this all-surpassing power is from God and not from us. We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed.

2 Corinthians 4:16 We do not lose heart

Therefore we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day.

2 Corinthians 5:17 If anyone is in Christ he is a new creation

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!

2 Corinthians 7:10 Godly sorrow brings repentance

Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to salvation and leaves no regret, but worldly sorrow brings death.

2 Corinthians 9:7-8 Determine in your heart what to give

Each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.

2 Corinthians 10:3-5 Weapons of our warfare

For though we live in the world, we do not wage war as the world does. The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds. We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.

2 Corinthians 12:9-10 My grace is sufficient for you

But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me. That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong.

Galatians

Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ

I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

Galatians 5:13 Called to be free

You, my brothers, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the sinful nature.

Galatians 5:22-23 The fruit of the Spirit

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

Galatians 6:7 Whatever you sow you will reap

Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows.

Ephesians

Ephesians 1:11-12 You were chosen and predestined

In him we were also chosen, having been predestined according to the plan of him who works out everything in conformity with the purpose of his will, in order that we, who were the first to hope in Christ, might be for the praise of his glory.

Ephesians 2:10 We are his workmanship

For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

Ephesians 2:8-9 By grace are you saved

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith--and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God--not by works, so that no one can boast.

Ephesians 3:20 He is able

Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us,

Ephesians 4:32 Forgive one another

Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

Ephesians 5:18-19 Be filled with the Spirit

Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit. Speak to one another with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs. Sing and make music in your heart to the Lord.

Ephesians 6:1 Children, obey your parents

Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. Honor your father and mother which is the first commandment with a promise.

Ephesians 6:10-11 Be strong in the Lord

Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on the full armor of God so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes.

Ephesians 6:13-15 Stand your ground

Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace.

Ephesians 6:16-17 The armor of God

Above all take the shield of faith, wherewith you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one, and take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit which is the Word of God.

Philippians

Philippians 1:29 Believe and suffer for him

For it has been granted to you on behalf of Christ not only to believe on him, but also to suffer for him,

Philippians 1:6 He began and will finish working on you

Being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.

Philippians 2:12-13 Work out your salvation

Work out your salvation with fear and trembling, for it is God who works in you to will and to act according to his good purpose.

Philippians 2:9-11 Jesus is exalted above every name

Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Philippians 3:12 I press toward the mark

Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already been made perfect, but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me.

Philippians 3:13-14 I press to win the prize

Brothers, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.

Philippians 4:4 Rejoice

Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!

Philippians 4:6-7 Don't worry

Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.

Philippians 4:7 The peace of God will guard your heart

And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

Philippians 4:8 Think on good things

Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable--if anything is excellent or praiseworthy--think about such things.

Philippians 4:13 I can do all things

I can do everything through him who gives me strength.

Philippians 4:19 God will supply all your needs

And my God will meet all your needs according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus.

Colossians

Colossians 1:15-16 Christ the Image of God

The Son is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. ¹⁶ For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him.

Colossians 1:17-20 The Supremacy of Christ

He is before all things, and in him all things hold together. ¹⁸ And he is the head of the body, the church; he is the beginning and the firstborn from among the dead, so that in everything he might have the supremacy. ¹⁹ For God was pleased to have all his fullness dwell in him, ²⁰ and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross.

Colossians 1:9 Paul's prayer for them

For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have not stopped praying for you. We continually ask God to fill you with the knowledge of his will through all the wisdom and understanding that the Spirit gives.

Colossians 1:13-14 He delivered us from the dominion of darkness

For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

Colossians 2:6-7 Rooted and grounded in Him

So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live your lives in him, rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness.

Colossians 2:9-10 Christ the fullness of God

For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form, and in Christ you have been brought to fullness. He is the head over every power and authority.

Colossians 2:14-15 He nailed them to the cross

He forgave us all our sins, having canceled the charge of our legal indebtedness, which stood against us and condemned us; he has taken it away, nailing it to the cross. And having disarmed the powers and authorities, he made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them by the cross.

Colossians 2:17 Old Testament customs are shadows of things to come.

These are a shadow of the things that were to come; the reality, however, is found in Christ.

Colossians 3:1-2 Set your mind on things above

Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things.

Colossians 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in Psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your heart to the Lord.

Colossians 3:20 Children, obey your parents

Children, obey your parents in everything, for this pleases the Lord.

Colossians 3:23 Whatever you do, do with all your heart

Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters.

Colossians 4:2 Devote yourself to prayer

Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful.

1 Thessalonians

1 Thessalonians 1:4-5 The Gospel with power

For we know, brothers and sisters loved by God, that he has chosen you, because our gospel came to you not simply with words but also with power, with the Holy Spirit and deep conviction.

1 Thessalonians 2:13 You accepted the word as of God

And we also thank God continually because, when you received the word of God, which you heard from us, you accepted it not as a human word, but as it actually is, the word of God, which is indeed at work in you who believe.

1 Thessalonians 3:13 That you may be blameless and holy

May he strengthen your hearts so that you will be blameless and holy in the presence of our God and Father when our Lord Jesus comes with all his holy ones.

1 Thessalonians 4:7 We are called to be pure

For God did not call us to be impure, but to live a holy life.

1 Thessalonians 4:11 Lead a quiet and peaceable life.

Make it your ambition to lead a quiet life, to mind your own business and to work with your hands, just as we told you.

1 Thessalonians 4:11 Lead a quiet and peaceful life

Make it your ambition to lead a quiet life: You should mind your own business and work with your hands, just as we told you,

1 Thessalonians 4:13-15 Christ is coming, comfort one another with this

Brothers, we do not want you to be ignorant about those who fall asleep, or to grieve like the rest of men, who have no hope. We believe that Jesus died and rose again and so we believe that God will bring with Jesus those who have fallen asleep in him. According to the Lord's own word, we tell you that we who are still alive, who are left till the coming of the Lord, will certainly not precede those who have fallen asleep. For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever. Therefore encourage each other with these words.

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 Be joyful, pray continually, give thanks

Be joyful always; pray continually; give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

1 Thessalonians 5:19-22 Test everything, hold on to the good

Do not put out the Spirit's fire; do not treat prophecies with contempt. Test everything. Hold on to the good. Avoid every kind of evil.

1 Thessalonians 5:23 May your body, soul, and spirit be preserved

May God himself, the God of peace, sanctify you through and through. May your whole spirit, soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

1 Thessalonians 5:24 Faithful is he who calls you

The one who calls you is faithful, and he will do it.

2 Thessalonians

2 Thessalonians 1:7-10 When Christ will come

When the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven in blazing fire with his powerful angels. he will punish those who do not know God and do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus. They will be punished with everlasting destruction and shut out from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of his might

2 Thessalonians 2:9

The coming of the lawless one will be in accordance with how Satan works. He will use all sorts of displays of power through signs and wonders that serve the

lie, and all the ways that wickedness deceives those who are perishing. They perish because they refused to love the truth and so be saved.

2 Thessalonians 2:13-14 God chose you to be saved and sanctified

But we ought always to thank God for you, brothers loved by the Lord, because from the beginning God chose you to be saved through the sanctifying work of the Spirit and through belief in the truth. He called you to this through our gospel, that you might share in the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.

2 Thessalonians 3:3 The Lord is faithful he will protect you

But the Lord is faithful, and he will strengthen and protect you from the evil one.

2 Thessalonians 3:16 May the Lord of peace give you peace

Now may the Lord of peace himself give you peace at all times and in every way. The Lord be with all of you.

1 Timothy

1 Timothy 1:9-11

We know that the law is good if one uses it properly. We also know that the law is made not for the righteous but for lawbreakers and rebels, the ungodly and sinful, the unholy and irreligious, for those who kill their fathers or mothers, for murderers, for the sexually immoral, for those practicing homosexuality, for slave traders and liars and perjurers—and for whatever else is contrary to the sound doctrine.

1 Timothy 1:17

Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, the only God, be honor and glory for ever and ever. Amen.

1 Timothy 2:1 Prayers and intercession for all men

I urge, then, first of all, that requests, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for everyone-- for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness.

1 Timothy 4:1-2 In last days men will be deceived and follow doctrines of devils

The Spirit clearly says that in later times some will abandon the faith and follow deceiving spirits and things taught by demons. Such teachings come through hypocritical liars, whose consciences have been seared as with a hot iron.

1 Timothy 4:7-8 Train yourself to be godly

Have nothing to do with godless myths and old wives' tales; rather, train yourself to be godly. For physical training is of some value, but godliness has value for all things, holding promise for both the present life and the life to come.

1 Timothy 4:12 Be an example of believer is word and lifestyle

Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in life, in love, in faith and in purity.

1 Timothy 6:10 The love of money is the root of all evil

For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil. Some people, eager for money, have wandered from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs.

1 Timothy 6:12 Fight the good fight of faith

Fight the good fight of the faith. Take hold of the eternal life to which you were called when you made your good confession in the presence of many witnesses.

2 Timothy

2 Timothy 1:7 God did not give us spirit of fear but of sound mind

For God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power, of love and of self-discipline.

2 Timothy 1:12 I know whom I have believed

Yet I am not ashamed, because I know whom I have believed, and am convinced that he is able to guard what I have entrusted to him for that day.

2 Timothy 2:8-9 The word of God is not chained

This is my gospel, for which I am suffering even to the point of being chained like a criminal. But God's word is not chained.

2 Timothy 2:15 Study to show yourself approved

Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a workman who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth.

2 Timothy 2:19 The Lord knows those who are his

Nevertheless, God's solid foundation stands firm, sealed with this inscription: "The Lord knows those who are his," and, "Everyone who confesses the name of the Lord must turn away from wickedness."

2 Timothy 2:20-21 A vessel prepared for the Master's use

In a large house there are articles not only of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay; some are for noble purposes and some for ignoble. If a man cleanses himself from the latter, he will be an instrument for noble purposes, made holy, useful to the Master and prepared to do any good work.

2 Timothy 2:25-266 Come to senses and escape devil's trap

Those who oppose him he must gently instruct, in the hope that God will grant them repentance leading them to a knowledge of the truth, and that they will

come to their senses and escape from the trap of the devil, who has taken them captive to do his will.

2 Timothy 3:1-5 In last days men will be lovers of self

But mark this: There will be terrible times in the last days. People will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boastful, proud, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy, without love, unforgiving, slanderous, without self-control, brutal, not lovers of the good, treacherous, rash, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God--having a form of godliness but denying its power. Have nothing to do with them.

2 Timothy 3:16-17 All Scripture is given by inspiration of God

All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

2 Timothy 4:7-8 I have fought the good fight of faith

I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. Now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day--and not only to me, but also to all who have longed for his appearing.

Titus

Titus 2:11-13 God teaches us to deny self

For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men. It teaches us to say "No" to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright and godly lives in this present age, while we wait for the blessed hope--the glorious appearing of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ.

Titus 3:4-6 He saved us because of his mercy

But when the kindness and love of God our Savior appeared, he saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior.

Philemon

Philemon 1:6 Be active sharing your faith

I pray that you may be active in sharing your faith, so that you will have a full understanding of every good thing we have in Christ.

Philemon 1:11 He once was useless, now useful

Formerly he was useless to you, but now he has become useful both to you and to me.

Hebrews

Hebrews 1:1-3 He is the radiance of God's glory

In the past God spoke to our forefathers through the prophets at many times and in various ways, but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom he made the universe. The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful word.

Hebrews 4:12 The word of God is alive

For the word of God is living and powerful and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to dividing the soul and spirit, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

Hebrews 4:16 Let us come boldly to the throne of grace

Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.

Hebrews 6:19 We have an anchor

We have this hope as an anchor for the soul, firm and secure.

Hebrews 7:25 He is able to save to the uttermost

Therefore he is able to save completely those who come to God through him, because he always lives to intercede for them.

Hebrews 10:25 Forsake not the assembling together

Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another--and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

Hebrews 10:31 The hands of God are fearful

It is a dreadful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.

Hebrews 11:1 Faith is the substance of hope

Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see.

Hebrews 11:6 Without faith it is impossible to please God

Without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.

Hebrews 12:1-2 Fix our eyes on Jesus

Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles, and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us. Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Hebrews 13:5 I will never leave you

Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you.

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ is the same forever

Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.

James

James 1:2-3 Pure joy in trials

Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance.

James 1:4-5 Perseverance makes you perfect

Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything.

James 1:6-8 If you need wisdom, ask

If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you. But when you ask, you must believe and not doubt, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind. That person should not expect to receive anything from the Lord. Such a person is double-minded and unstable in all they do.

James 1:12 Trials and the crown of life

Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life that the Lord has promised to those who love him.

James 1:22 Be doers of the word

Be doers of the word and not hearers only deceiving yourselves.

James 1:2-3 Joy in trials

Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance.

James 1:5-6 Ask for wisdom

If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you. But when you ask, you must believe and not doubt, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind. That person should not expect to receive anything from the Lord.

James 1:13 Trials bring a crown of life

Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life that the Lord has promised to those who love him.

James 1:13-15 When you are tempted

When tempted, no one should say, "God is tempting me." For God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does he tempt anyone; but each person is tempted when they are dragged away by their own evil desire and enticed. Then, after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death.

James 1:16-17

Don't be deceived, my dear brothers and sisters. Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows.

James 1:22-23 Listen and Do the Word

Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says. Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is like someone who looks at his face in a mirror and, after looking at himself, goes away and immediately forgets what he looks like. But whoever looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and continues in it—not forgetting what they have heard, but doing it—they will be blessed in what they do.

James 2:6 God has chosen the poor

Listen, my dear brothers and sisters: Has not God chosen those who are poor in the eyes of the world to be rich in faith and to inherit the kingdom he promised those who love him?

James 2:8 Love your neighbor as yourself

If you really keep the royal law found in Scripture, "Love your neighbor as yourself," you are doing right.

James 2:10 Offend the law in one point is guilty of all

For whoever keeps the whole law and yet stumbles at just one point is guilty of breaking all of it.

James 2:23 Abraham believed God

And the scripture was fulfilled that says, "Abraham believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness," and he was called God's friend.

James 3:2 The tongue is a world of wickedness

We all stumble in many ways. Anyone who is never at fault in what they say is perfect, able to keep their whole body in check. When we put bits into the mouths of horses to make them obey us, we can turn the whole animal. Or take ships as an example. Although they are so large and are driven by strong winds, they are

steered by a very small rudder wherever the pilot wants to go. Likewise, the tongue is a small part of the body, but it makes great boasts. Consider what a great forest is set on fire by a small spark. The tongue also is a fire, a world of evil among the parts of the body. It corrupts the whole body, sets the whole course of one's life on fire, and is itself set on fire by hell.

James 3:14-16

But if you harbor bitter envy and selfish ambition in your hearts, do not boast about it or deny the truth. ¹⁵ Such "wisdom" does not come down from heaven but is earthly, unspiritual, demonic. For where you have envy and selfish ambition, there you find disorder and every evil practice.

James 4:3 Asking with wrong motives

When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, that you may spend what you get on your pleasures.

James 4:7-8 Resist the devil

Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw near to God and he will come near to you.

James 4:10 Humble yourselves

Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up.

James 5:9 Don't grumble

Don't grumble against one another, brothers and sisters, or you will be judged. The Judge is standing at the door!

James 5:13-16 If you are sick, pray!

Is anyone among you in trouble? Let them pray. Is anyone happy? Let them sing songs of praise. Is anyone among you sick? Let them call the elders of the church to pray over them and anoint them with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise them up. If they have sinned, they will be forgiven.

James 5:16 Confess your faults one to another

Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.

1 Peter

1 Peter 1:6-7 Rejoice in your trials

In all this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while you may have had to suffer grief in all kinds of trials. These have come so that the proven genuineness of your faith—of greater worth than gold, which perishes even though refined by fire—may result in praise, glory and honor when Jesus Christ is revealed.

1 Peter 1:15-16 Be holy for I am holy

But just as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; for it is written: “Be holy, because I am holy.”

1 Peter 1:23 You have been born again

For you have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God.

1 Peter 1:24-25 The word of the Lord endures forever

The grass withers and the flowers fall, but the word of the Lord endures forever.

1 Peter 2:2 Desire the milk of the word

As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word that you may grow thereby:

1 Peter 2:9 You are a chosen generation

But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a peculiar people; that you should show forth the praises of him who has called you out of darkness into his marvelous light:

1 Peter 2:21 Walk in his steps

To this you were called, because Christ suffered for you, leaving you an example, that you should follow in his steps.

1 Peter 3:12 The eyes of the Lord

For the eyes of the Lord are over the righteous, and his ears are open unto their prayers: but the face of the Lord is against them that do evil.

1 Peter 3:15 Be ready to give an answer

But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asks you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear:

1 Peter 4:12-13 Fiery trials

Beloved, think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened unto you: But rejoice, inasmuch as you are partakers of Christ’s sufferings; that, when his glory shall be revealed, you may be glad also with exceeding joy.

1 Peter 5:7 Cast all your care

Casting all your care upon him; for he cares for you.

1 Peter 5:8 A roaring lion seeking to devour

Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.

1 Peter 5:10 Restore you and make you strong

And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast.

2 Peter

2 Peter 1:3-4 Great and precious promises

His divine power has given us everything we need for life and godliness through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness. Through these he has given us his very great and precious promises, so that through them you may participate in the divine nature and escape the corruption in the world caused by evil desires.

2 Peter 1:5-8 Add to your faith

For this very reason, make every effort to add to your faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; and to godliness, brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness, love. For if you possess these qualities in increasing measure, they will keep you from being ineffective and unproductive in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.

2 Peter 1:10-11 Make your calling and election sure

Therefore, my brothers, be all the more eager to make your calling and election sure. For if you do these things, you will never fall, and you will receive a rich welcome into the eternal kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

2 Peter 1:21 Inspiration of Scripture

Above all, you must understand that no prophecy of Scripture came about by the prophet's own interpretation of things. For prophecy never had its origin in the human will, but prophets, though human, spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit.

2 Peter 2:9-10 God can rescue godly men

The Lord knows how to rescue godly men from trials and to hold the unrighteous for the day of judgment, while continuing their punishment.

2 Peter 3:9 God is not slow

The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. He is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.

2 Peter 3:10-12 The elements will melt

But the day of the Lord will come like a thief. The heavens will disappear with a roar; the elements will be destroyed by fire, and the earth and everything in it will be laid bare. Since everything will be destroyed in this way, what kind of people ought you to be? You ought to live holy and godly lives as you look forward to the day of God and speed its coming. That day will bring about the destruction of the heavens by fire, and the elements will melt in the heat.

1 John

1 John 1:8 If we say we have not sinned we lie

If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

1 John 2:14 You are strong the word lives in you

I write to you, young men, because you are strong, and the word of God lives in you, and you have overcome the evil one.

1 John 2:15-16 Love not the world

Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

1 John 3:8 Jesus came to destroy the work of the devil

The one who does what is sinful is of the devil, because the devil has been sinning from the beginning. The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the devil's work.

1 John 3:21-23 Love one another.

Dear friends, if our hearts do not condemn us, we have confidence before God and receive from him anything we ask, because we obey his commands and do what pleases him. And this is his command: to believe in the name of his Son, Jesus Christ, and to love one another as he commanded us.

1 John 4:4 Greater is He that is in us

You are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.

1 John 4:1 Perfect love casts out fear

There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out fear, because fear has to do with punishment. The one who fears is not made perfect in love.

1 John 4:19 He first loved us.

We love because he first loved us.

1 John 5:3 His commands are not burdensome

This is love for God: to obey his commands. And his commands are not burdensome.

1 John 5:12 He that has the Son has life

He that has the Son has life; and he that hath not the Son of God has not life.

1 John 5:14-15 He hears our prayers

And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he hears us: And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.

1 John 5:4 We overcome the world

For whosoever is born of God overcomes the world: and this is the victory that overcomes the world, even our faith.

Watch out that you do not lose what you have worked for, but that you may be rewarded fully. Anyone who runs ahead and does not continue in the teaching of Christ does not have God; whoever continues in the teaching has both the Father and the Son.

Revelation 3:20 Behold I stand at the door and knock

Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with him, and he with me.

Revelation 12:10-11 They overcame with the blood of the Lamb

Now have come the salvation and the power and the kingdom of our God, and the authority of his Messiah. For the accuser of our brothers and sisters, who accuses them before our God day and night, has been hurled down. They triumphed over him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony; they did not love their lives so much as to shrink from death.

Revelation 22:17 Come, anyone who is thirsty.

The Spirit and the bride say, "Come!" And let him who hears say, "Come!" Whoever is thirsty, let him come; and whoever wishes, let him take the free gift of the water of life.

Revelation 20:12, 15 The Book of Life

And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Another book was opened, which is the book of life. The dead were judged according to what they had done as recorded in the books. ¹⁵ Anyone whose name was not found written in the book of life was thrown into the lake of fire.

Revelation 21:8 Those who won't be in heaven

But the cowardly, the unbelieving, the vile, the murderers, the sexually immoral, those who practice magic arts, the idolaters and all liars—they will be consigned to the fiery lake of burning sulfur. This is the second death."

Revelation 22:18-19 A Final Warning

I warn everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: If anyone adds anything to them, God will add to him the plagues described in this book. And if anyone takes words away from this book of prophecy, God will take away from him his share in the tree of life and in the holy city, which are described in this book.
