How To Pray In The Spirit

Adapted from YWAM by Richard W. LaFountain (I Cor 14:15, Eph. 6:19, Jude 1:20)

My Part (Internal)

Deal with Sin - (**Me**) <u>Words, Actions, Thoughts, Attitudes, (W.A.T.A.)</u> (Psalm 66:18, Ps 139:23-24, Is 59:1,2, Mt 5:23-24) *Put on "sin-block"*

Deal with Self & Flesh - (**Myself**) "*The spirit is willing, the flesh is weak*" Matthew 26:41 (who's on first? Who is on the throne?) Selfish desires and wants must be laid down. Breathe in the Holy Spirit. Ask for the Holy Spirit to take control of desires. Be in the Spirit, worship in the Spirit and pray in the Spirit. (Romans 8:8, 8:27, James 4:3, Gal 5:16,25)

Deal with Thoughts - (I) Reign in the wandering mind. His thoughts are not Your thoughts. (Is 26:3, Is 55:8, 2 Corinthians 10:3-4) "*Bring every thought into the captivity of Christ.*"

Devil's Part (External)

Deal with the Devil - He is the hinderer, thief, liar, destroyer, murderer, deceiver (Daniel 9, Zech 3, I Pet 5:9, Rev 12, Eph 6) Resist him steadfastly. Having not dealt with him we are hindered by him. He is allowed to go unchecked, unfettered, ungagged. "We wrestle not against flesh and blood but principalities and powers.")

God's Part (Eternal)

Agree with God - "*We know not how to pray as we ought.*" Romans 8:26-27, Proverbs 3:5, Luke 22:42 "*Nevertheless not my will but thy will be done.*" Matthew 6:10 "*Thy will be done...*"

Believe God - Believe and expect God to lead you by His voice and revelation. (Rom 8:14) Believing prayer is acceptable to God. Wishing and hoping are not the same as confident believing prayer. (James 1:6-7, Hebrews 11:6, Romans 4:20)

Wait for God - Wait on God. Wait patiently for His burden and direction (Stand Still, be still, keep silence) Psalm 46:10, Psalm 27:14, Ps 37:7, Is 40:31

Too often we pray with prepared lists of requests in our hands. There is a place for the lists as reminders of immediate needs, but too much leaning on the fleshly mind will miss the mind of the Spirit. The Spirit prays for us with groanings that cannot be articulated (or listed). Seek to pray the heart of God – which is the mind of the Spirit.

How To Pray For Lost Souls

Pray Scripture

It is not an easy task to remain faithful in prayer for a lost soul. Though we may know the need, feel the burden, and even have some indication of what God must do in order for them to come to Christ, it still is a difficult task to keep at it and not grow weary, or bored in the task. After perhaps a week of prayer we all begin to wonder "What more can we pray for?"

The following is a helpful guide for praying for a lost soul by reading, reviewing, and reusing Scriptures in your prayer for the one on your <u>Ten Most</u> <u>Wanted List</u>. It is in the format of a daily devotional to help direct your thinking. There are eight points. You may want to choose seven, one for each day of the week to keep you focused and intense in your prevailing prayers for the lost. Pray for your most wanted people daily using this to guide your praying.

<u>PRAY FOR HIS CONDITION</u>: A MAN BEFORE SALVATION

- 1. He needs the grace of God to lead him to repentance John 6:44
- 2. He is <u>a slave to sin</u>. John 8:34
- 3. He does not see his sin as very sinful. John 16:8-11
- 4. He chokes out the Word with other interests. Luke 8:12-14
- 5. He has rejected, ignored, or neglected God's presence. Rom 1:18-20
- 6. He has a sin nature I Corinthians 2:14
- 7. He is <u>blinded</u> to the Gospel by Satan. 2 Corinthians 4:3-4
- 8. He is dead is sins and trespasses. Ephesians 2:1
- 9. He willfully walks in disobedience Ephesians 2:2
- 10. He obeys the prince of darkness. Ephesians 2:2
- 11. He serves his own desires of the mind and body. Ephesians 2:3
- 12. He has no faith. Ephesians 2:8-9
- 13. He is separated from God, alienated by sin. Ephesians 2:12
