Psalm 5: 11. But let all who take refuge in you be glad; let them ever sing for joy. Spread your protection over them, that those who love your name may rejoice in you. 12. For surely, O LORD, you bless the righteous; you surround them with your favor as with a shield.

Psalm 7: 10. My shield is God Most High, who saves the upright in heart. 17. I will give thanks to the LORD because of his righteousness and will sing praise to the name of the LORD Most High.

Psalm 8: 1. O LORD, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth! You have set your glory above the heavens. 2. From the lips of children and infants you have ordained praise because of your enemies, to silence the foe and the avenger. 9. O LORD, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth!

Psalm 9: 1. I will praise you, O LORD, with all my heart; I will tell of all your wonders. 2. I will be glad and rejoice in you; I will sing praise to your name, O Most High. 9. The LORD is a refuge for the oppressed, a stronghold in times of trouble. 10. Those who know your name will trust in you, for you, LORD, have never forsaken those who seek you. 11. Sing praises to the LORD, enthroned in Zion; proclaim among the nations what he has done.

Psalm 13: 6. I will sing to the LORD, for he has been good to me.

Psalm 20 5. We will shout for joy when you are victorious and will lift up our banners in the name of our God. May the LORD grant all your requests. 6. Now I know that the LORD saves his anointed; he answers him from his holy heaven with the saving power of his right hand. 7. Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the LORD our God.

Psalm 21: 1. O LORD, the king rejoices in your strength. How great is his joy in the victories you give! 13. Be exalted, O LORD, in your strength; we will sing and praise your might.

Psalm 22: 3. Yet you are enthroned as the Holy One; you are the praise of Israel. 22. I will declare your name to my brothers; in the congregation I will praise you. 23. You who fear the LORD, praise him! All you descendants of Jacob, honor him! Revere him, all you descendants of Israel!

Psalm 24: 7. Lift up your heads, O you gates; be lifted up, you ancient doors, that the King of glory may come in. 8. Who is this King of glory? The LORD strong and mighty, the LORD mighty in battle. 9. Lift up your heads, O you gates; lift them up, you ancient doors, that the King of glory may come in. 10. Who is he, this King of glory? The LORD Almighty-- he is the King of glory. Selah

Psalm 27: 1. The LORD is my light and my salvation-- whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life-- of whom shall I be afraid? 4. One thing I ask of the LORD, this is what I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to gaze upon the beauty of the LORD and to seek him in his temple. 13. I am still confident of this: I will see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living. 14. Wait for the LORD; be strong and take heart and wait for the LORD.

Psalm 29: (ALL) 1. Give unto the Lord, O ye mighty, give unto the Lord glory and strength. 2. Give unto the Lord the glory due unto his name; worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness. 3. The voice of the Lord

is upon the waters: the God of glory thundereth: the Lord is upon many waters. 4. The voice of the Lord is powerful; the voice of the Lord is full of majesty. 5. The voice of the Lord breaketh the cedars; yea, the Lord breaketh the cedars of Lebanon. 6. He maketh them also to skip like a calf; Lebanon and Sirion like a young unicorn. 7. The voice of the Lord divideth the flames of fire. 8. The voice of the Lord shaketh the wilderness; the Lord shaketh the wilderness of Kadesh. 9. The voice of the Lord maketh the hinds to calve, and discovereth the forests: and in his temple doth every one speak of his glory. 10. The Lord sitteth upon the flood; yea, the Lord sitteth king for ever. 11. The Lord will give strength unto his people; the Lord will bless his people with peace.

Psalm 33: 1. Sing joyfully to the LORD, you righteous; it is fitting for the upright to praise him. 2. Praise the LORD with the harp; make music to him on the ten-stringed lyre. 3. Sing to him a new song; play skillfully, and shout for joy. 4. For the word of the LORD is right and true; he is faithful in all he does.

Psalm 34: 1. I will extol the LORD at all times; his praise will always be on my lips. 2. My soul will boast in the LORD; let the afflicted hear and rejoice. 3. Glorify the LORD with me; let us exalt his name together. 4. I sought the LORD, and he answered me; he delivered me from all my fears.

Psalm 35: 9. Then my soul will rejoice in the LORD and delight in his salvation. 27. May those who delight in my vindication shout for joy and gladness; may they always say, "The LORD be exalted, who delights in the well-being of his servant." 28. My tongue will speak of your righteousness and of your praises all day long.

Psalm 40: 1. I waited patiently for the LORD; he turned to me and heard my cry. 2. He lifted me out of the slimy pit, out of the mud and mire; he set my feet on a rock and gave me a firm place to stand. 3. He put a new song in my mouth, a hymn of praise to our God. Many will see and fear and put their trust in the LORD.

Psalm 44: 5. Through you we push back our enemies; through your name we trample our foes. 6. I do not trust in my bow, my sword does not bring me victory; 8. In God we make our boast all day long, and we will praise your name forever. Selah

Psalm 45: 17. I will perpetuate your memory through all generations; therefore the nations will praise you for ever and ever.

Psalm 46: 1. God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble. 2. Therefore we will not fear, though the earth give way and the mountains fall into the heart of the sea, 3. though its waters roar and foam and the mountains quake with their surging. Selah 10. "Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth." 11. The LORD Almighty is with us; the God of Jacob is our fortress. Selah

Psalm 47: 1. Clap your hands, all you nations; shout to God with cries of joy. 2. How awesome is the LORD Most High, the great King over all the earth! 5. God has ascended amid shouts of joy, the LORD amid the sounding of trumpets. 6. Sing praises to God, sing praises; sing praises to our King, sing praises. 7. For God is the King of all the earth; sing to him a psalm of praise.

Psalm 48: 1. Great is the LORD, and most worthy of praise, in the city of our God, his holy mountain. 2. It is beautiful in its loftiness, the joy of the whole earth. Like the utmost heights of Zaphon is Mount Zion, the city of the Great King.

Psalm 50: 23. He who sacrifices thank offerings honors me, and he prepares the way so that I may show him the salvation of God."

Psalm 51: 15. O Lord, open my lips, and my mouth will declare your praise.

Psalm 52: 8. But I am like an olive tree flourishing in the house of God; I trust in God's unfailing love for ever and ever. 9. I will praise you forever for what you have done; in your name I will hope, for your name is good. I will praise you in the presence of your saints.

Psalm 54: 4. Surely God is my help; the Lord is the one who sustains me. 6. I will sacrifice a freewill offering to you; I will praise your name, O LORD, for it is good.

Psalm 56: 3. When I am afraid, I will trust in you. 4. In God, whose word I praise, in God I trust; I will not be afraid. What can mortal man do to me? 10. In God, whose word I praise, in the LORD, whose word I praise-- 11. in God I trust; I will not be afraid. What can man do to me?

Psalm 57: 7. My heart is steadfast, O God, my heart is steadfast; I will sing and make music. 8. Awake, my soul! Awake, harp and lyre! I will awaken the dawn. 9. I will praise you, O Lord, among the nations; I will sing of you among the peoples. 10. For great is your love, reaching to the heavens; your faithfulness reaches to the skies. 11. Be exalted, O God, above the heavens; let your glory be over all the earth.

Psalm 59: 16. But I will sing of your strength, in the morning I will sing of your love; for you are my fortress, my refuge in times of trouble. 17. O my Strength, I sing praise to you; you, O God, are my fortress, my loving God.

Psalm 61: 8. Then will I ever sing praise to your name and fulfill my vows day after day.

Psalm 63: 1. O God, you are my God, earnestly I seek you; my soul thirsts for you, my body longs for you, in a dry and weary land where there is no water. 2. I have seen you in the sanctuary and beheld your power and your glory. 3. Because your love is better than life, my lips will glorify you. 4. I will praise you as long as I live, and in your name I will lift up my hands.

Psalm 65: 1. Praise awaits you, O God, in Zion; to you our vows will be fulfilled. 2. O you who hear prayer, to you all men will come. 3. When we were overwhelmed by sins, you forgave our transgressions. 4. Blessed are those you choose and bring near to live in your courts! We are filled with the good things of your house, of your holy temple.

Psalm 66: 1. Make a joyful noise unto God, all ye lands: 2. Sing forth the honour of his name: make his praise glorious. 3. Say unto God, How terrible art thou in thy works! through the greatness of thy power shall thine enemies submit themselves unto thee. 4. All the earth shall worship thee, and shall sing unto thee; they shall sing to thy name. Selah. 8. O bless our God, ye people, and make the voice of his praise to be heard:

Psalm 67: 3. May the peoples praise you, O God; may all the peoples praise you. 4. May the nations be glad and sing for joy, for you rule the peoples justly and guide the nations of the earth. Selah 5. May the peoples praise you, O God; may all the peoples praise you.

Psalm 68: 3. But may the righteous be glad and rejoice before God; may they be happy and joyful. 4. Sing to God, sing praise to his name, extol him who rides on the clouds -- his name is the LORD-- and rejoice before him. 19. Praise be to the Lord, to God our Savior, who daily bears our burdens. Selah 20. Our God is a God who saves; from the Sovereign LORD comes escape from death. 32. Sing to God, O kingdoms of the earth, sing praise to the Lord, Selah 33. to him who rides the ancient skies above, who thunders with mighty voice. 34. Proclaim the power of God, whose majesty is over Israel, whose power is in the skies.

Psalm 69: 30. I will praise God's name in song and glorify him with thanksgiving. 31. This will please the LORD more than an ox, more than a bull with its horns and hoofs. 32. The poor will see and be glad-- you who seek God, may your hearts live!

Psalm 71: 14. But as for me, I will always have hope; I will praise you more and more. 15. My mouth will tell of your righteousness, of your salvation all day long, though I know not its measure. 16. I will come and proclaim your mighty acts, O Sovereign LORD; I will proclaim your righteousness, yours alone. 17. Since my youth, O God, you have taught me, and to this day I declare your marvelous deeds. 18. Even when I am old and gray, do not forsake me, O God, till I declare your power to the next generation, your might to all who are to come. 22. I will praise you with the harp for your faithfulness, O my God; I will sing praise to you with the lyre, O Holy One of Israel. 23. My lips will shout for joy when I sing praise to you-- I, whom you have redeemed. 24. My tongue will tell of your righteous acts all day long, for those who wanted to harm me have been put to shame and confusion.

Psalm 72: 17. May his name endure forever; may it continue as long as the sun. All nations will be blessed through him, and they will call him blessed. 18. Praise be to the LORD God, the God of Israel, who alone does marvelous deeds. 19. Praise be to his glorious name forever; may the whole earth be filled with his glory. Amen and Amen.

Psalm 73: 23. Yet I am always with you; you hold me by my right hand. 24. You guide me with your counsel, and afterward you will take me into glory. 25. Whom have I in heaven but you? And earth has nothing I desire besides you.

Psalm 74: 12. But you, O God, are my king from of old; you bring salvation upon the earth.

Psalm 77: 10. Then I thought, "To this I will appeal: the years of the right hand of the Most High." 11. I will remember the deeds of the LORD; yes, I will remember your miracles of long ago. 12. I will meditate on all your works and consider all your mighty deeds. 13. Your ways, O God, are holy. What god is so great as our God? 14. You are the God who performs miracles; you display your power among the peoples. 15. With your mighty arm you redeemed your people, the descendants of Jacob and Joseph. Selah

Psalm 81: 1. Sing for joy to God our strength; shout aloud to the God of Jacob! 2. Begin the music, strike the tambourine, play the melodious harp and lyre. 3. Sound the ram's horn at the New Moon, and when the moon is full, on the day of our Feast; 4. this is a decree for Israel, an ordinance of the God of Jacob.

Psalm 84: 1. How lovely is your dwelling place, O LORD Almighty! 2. My soul yearns, even faints, for the courts of the LORD; my heart and my flesh cry out for the living God. 3. Even the sparrow has found a home, and the swallow a nest for herself, where she may have her young-- a place near your altar, O LORD Almighty, my King and my God. 4. Blessed are those who dwell in your house; they are ever praising you. Selah 9. Look upon our shield, O God; look with favor on your anointed one. 10. Better is one day in your courts than a thousand elsewhere; I would rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God than dwell in the tents of the wicked. 11. For the LORD God is a sun and shield; the LORD bestows favor and honor; no good thing does he withhold from those whose walk is blameless. 12. O LORD Almighty, blessed is the man who trusts in you.

Psalm 86: 4. Bring joy to your servant, for to you, O Lord, I lift up my soul. 5. You are forgiving and good, O Lord, abounding in love to all who call to you. 8. Among the gods there is none like you, O Lord; no deeds can compare with yours. 9. All the nations you have made will come and worship before you, O Lord; they will bring glory to your name. 10. For you are great and do marvelous deeds; you alone are God. 11. Teach me your way, O LORD, and I will walk in your truth; give me an undivided heart, that I may fear your name. 12. I will praise you, O Lord my God, with all my heart; I will glorify your name forever.

Psalm 89: 1. I will sing of the LORD's great love forever; with my mouth I will make your faithfulness known through all generations. 5. The heavens praise your wonders, O LORD, your faithfulness too, in the assembly of the holy ones.

Psalm 90: 1. Lord, you have been our dwelling place throughout all generations. 2. Before the mountains were born or you brought forth the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God.

Psalm 91: 1. He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty. 2. I will say of the LORD, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust." 3. Surely he will save you from the fowler's snare and from the deadly pestilence. 4. He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness will be your shield and rampart.

Psalm 92: 1. It is good to praise the LORD and make music to your name, O Most High, 2. to proclaim your love in the morning and your faithfulness at night, 3. to the music of the ten-stringed lyre and the melody of the harp. 4. For you make me glad by your deeds, O LORD; I sing for joy at the works of your hands. 5. How great are your works, O LORD, how profound your thoughts!

Psalm 93: 1. The LORD reigns, he is robed in majesty; the LORD is robed in majesty and is armed with strength. The world is firmly established; it cannot be moved. 2. Your throne was established long ago; you are from all eternity. 3. The seas have lifted up, O LORD, the seas have lifted up their voice; the seas have lifted up their pounding waves. 4. Mightier than the thunder of the great waters, mightier than the breakers of the sea-- the LORD on high is mighty. 5. Your statutes stand firm; holiness adorns your house for endless days, O LORD.

Psalm 95: 1. Come, let us sing for joy to the LORD; let us shout aloud to the Rock of our salvation. 2. Let us come before him with thanksgiving and extol him with music and song. 3. For the LORD is the great God, the great King above all gods. 4. In his hand are the depths of the earth, and the mountain peaks belong to him. 5. The sea is his, for he made it, and his hands formed the dry land. 6. Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the LORD our Maker; 7. for he is our God and we are the people of his pasture, the flock under his care. Today, if you hear his voice,

Psalm 96:(ALL) 1. Sing to the LORD a new song; sing to the LORD, all the earth. 2. Sing to the LORD, praise his name; proclaim his salvation day after day. 3. Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous deeds among all peoples. 4. For great is the LORD and most worthy of praise; he is to be feared above all gods. 5. For all the gods of the nations are idols, but the LORD made the heavens. 6. Splendor and majesty are before him; strength and glory are in his sanctuary. 7. Ascribe to the LORD, O families of nations, ascribe to the LORD glory and strength. 8. Ascribe to the LORD the glory due his name; bring an offering and come into his courts. 9. Worship the LORD in the splendor of his holiness; tremble before him, all the earth. 10. Say among the nations, "The LORD reigns." The world is firmly established, it cannot be moved; he will judge the peoples with equity. 11. Let the heavens rejoice, let the earth be glad; let the sea resound, and all that is in it; 12. let the fields be jubilant, and everything in them. Then all the trees of the forest will sing for joy; 13. they will sing before the LORD, for he comes, he comes to judge the earth. Psalm 97: 1. The LORD reigns, let the earth be glad; let the distant shores rejoice. 6. The heavens proclaim his righteousness, and all the peoples see his glory. 9. For you, O LORD, are the Most High over all the earth; you are exalted far above all gods. 12. Rejoice in the LORD, you who are righteous, and praise his holy name.

Psalm 98:(ALL) 1. Sing to the LORD a new song, for he has done marvelous things; his right hand and his holy arm have worked salvation for him. 2. The LORD has made his salvation known and revealed his righteousness to the nations. 3. He has remembered his love and his faithfulness to the house of Israel; all the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God. 4. Shout for joy to the LORD, all the earth, burst into jubilant song with music; 5. make music to the LORD with the harp, with the harp and the sound of singing, 6. with trumpets and the blast of the ram's horn-- shout for joy before the LORD, the King. 7. Let the sea resound, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it. 8. Psalm 100:(ALL) 1. Shout for joy to the LORD, all the earth. 2. Worship the LORD with gladness; come before him with joyful songs. 3. Know that the LORD is God. It is he who made us, and we are his ; we are his people, the sheep of his pasture. 4. Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name. 5. For the LORD is good and his love endures forever; his faithfulness continues through all generations.

Psalm 101: 1. I will sing of your love and justice; to you, O LORD, I will sing praise.

Psalm 103: 1. Praise the LORD, O my soul; all my inmost being, praise his holy name. 2. Praise the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits-- 3. who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases, 4. who redeems your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion, 5. who satisfies your desires with good things so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's. 20. Praise the LORD, you his angels, you mighty ones who do his bidding, who obey his word. 21. Praise the LORD, all his heavenly hosts, you his servants who do his will. 22. Praise the LORD, all his works everywhere in his dominion. Praise the LORD, O my soul.
